Roadside Rest Area Fuwatto Tomamae

Adjacent to the camp ground and heated pool, this facility houses the rest area and the hot spring. Enjoy the view and some fresh seafood at the restaurant or a soft cone in the lounge. Dip your feet in the footbath while you gaze at Teuri and Yagishiri in the distance. You might even see Mt. Rishiri on the horizon.

Restaruant Kokoro

Tomamae Town Hall and Tomamae Da Bear

The iconic bear statue of Tomamae is hard to miss. Legend has it that it turns to watch as people go by.

Uehira Greenhill Windfarm

Located 6 km south from Tomamae, the windmills dot the hillside pasture at one of the largest wind farms in Japan. Strong winds from the Sea of Japan keep the long white arms in motion.

Sankebetsu attack replica

This replica portrays the scene of a horrible day in 1929 when a gigantic grizzly broke through a dwelling roof to get at the people inside. This attack became the deadliest in Japanese history. Follow Route 1049 towards Sankebetsu, then look for the "Bear Road" sign.

"Kuma arashi" (bear storm) by Yoshimura Akira

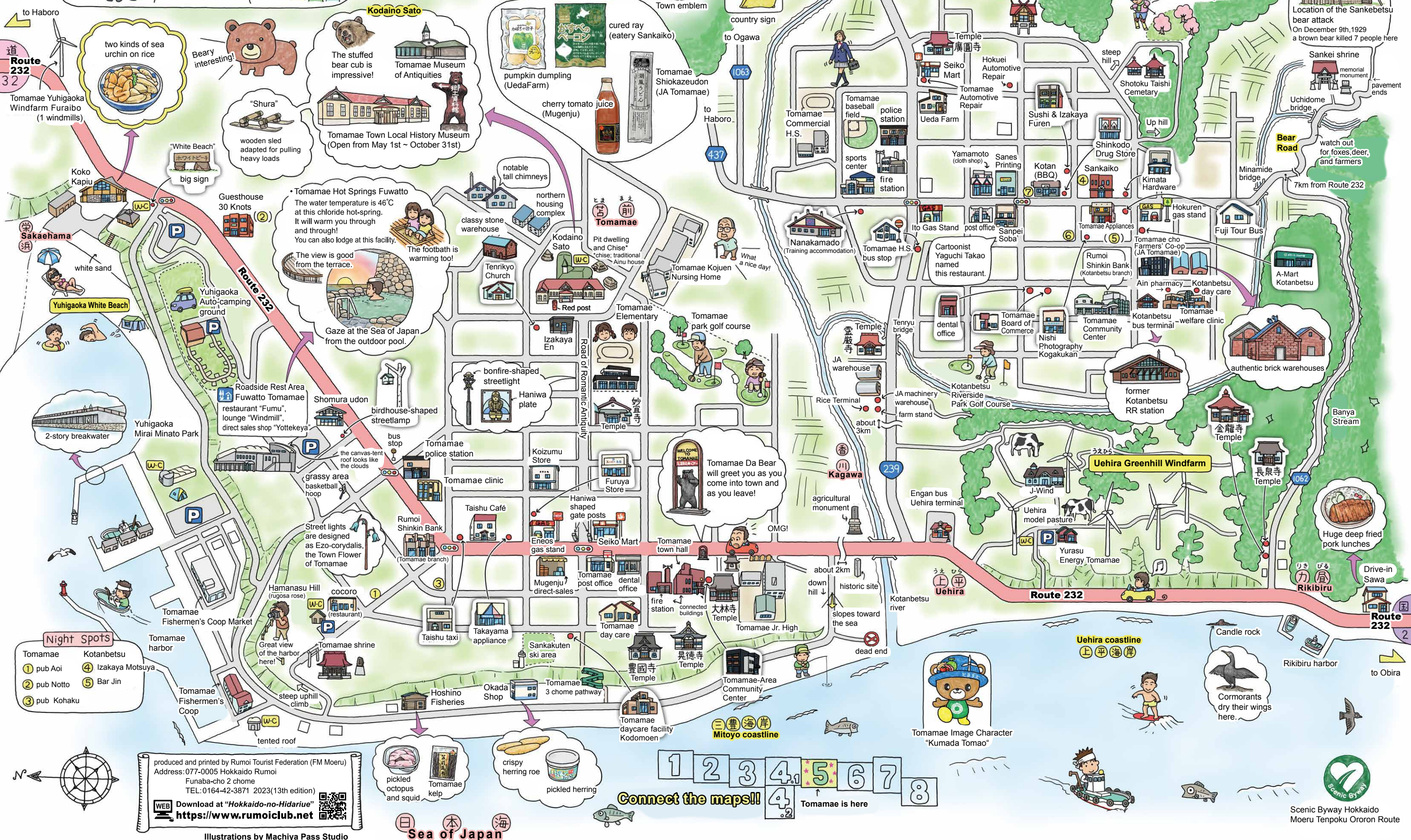
The novel based on the Sankebetsu bear attack was also made into a TV and radio drama.
