Ororon Line Cycling Route

Starting in Mashike, the first-half climax of this route appears when you pass through Tomamae and roll into Haboro. The white windmills of Uehira Greenhill Windfarm line up adjacent to Tomamae town. Refresh your feet at the Roadside Rest Area Fuwatto Tomamae footbath before the short push to Haboro. The majestic windmills of Yuhigaoka Windfarm will pull your gaze as you travel north!

Tomamae Yuhigaoka Auto-camping Ground

Located adjacent to Roadside Rest Area Fuwatto Tomamae, this campground is equipped with a center house, laundromat, showers and Wi-Fi. Reservations can be made online with the QR code. Enjoy the spectacular view of Teuri and Yagishiri Islands sitting on the horizon beyond White Beach and Tomamae Harbor. Fishing boats and the setting sun add to the ever-changing scenery along the Sea of Japan.

Roadside Rest Area Fuwatto Tomamae Where you can relax, savor and enjoy Tomamae

Look for the white domed roof near the coast on Route 232. This facility is equipped with a hot-springs, restaurant, lounge and retail shop Yottekeya.

Hot Spring

This natural hot spring is popular for its cavern-like bath, jacuzzi, sauna and outdoor bathing area. Deckchairs in the bathing "rest-area" invite you to sit and gaze at the sea for a spell. Sauna hats etc. can be purchased for a comfortable sauna experience.

Restaurant

The menu of restaurant Fumu features locally caught seafood. Enjoy a coffee or a light meal while you take in the view at WINDMILL Lounge.

Direct-sales shop

A variety of local products and seasonal specialties are sold at Yottekeya. The lineup includes both fresh and processed agricultural and marine products. You will find something delicious here for sure!
